Construction Update

Construction continues to progress on the water line and Dimsdale booster station with approximately 22 km (of 26 km total) installed. The project was delayed due to extreme cold weather in February and a manufacturing delay for the booster station electrical equipment; at this point it is estimated that completion of commissioning will be complete in early May.

Reclamation of the water line construction areas will occur in May and June as weather conditions warm up.

Where is the water sourced from?

The water that Aquatera treats originates from a pristine British Columbia lake. Your water travels 143 km from Wapiti Lake, B.C., to the Wapiti River, where Aquatera pumps it to the treatment plant for processing south of Grande Prairie.



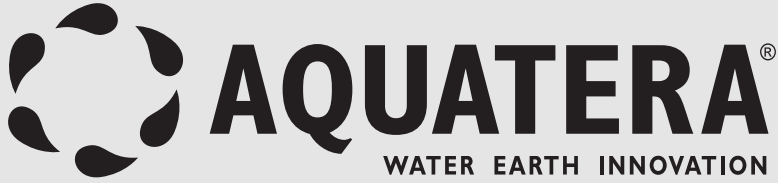
Will I have to have a new water meter installed?

Most properties in Wembley had a water meter installed in 2016 when Aquatera was contracted for the project.

Will my billing date change?

Aquatera's billing process is a little different than the Town of Wembley's. Your water meter will continue to be read the first week of the month, which means your bill will still be produced and sent out around the same time. Water bills are due the fourth Friday of the month – three weeks after receipt.
